**Problem 1:  
Underage drinking**  
(CLYDE survey 8<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> grade ICSD)

**Measure, Data, Source & Date #1:**  
Q8. 30-day use CLYDE Survey 2021 16.6%  
Q10. 30-day use CLYDE Survey 2023 14.4% (√ 2.2%)  
**Measure, Data, Source & Date #2:**  
Lifetime Use - had alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, or hard liquor) to drink - more than just a few sips?  
Q7. One or more times CLYDE 2021 31.6%  
Q8. One or more times CLYDE 2023 26.7% (√ 4.9%)

**Root Cause 1.1:  
Low Perception of risk of harm (by youth and parents)**

**Measure, Data, Source & Date #1:**  
Question 9. How much do you think people risk harming themselves (physically or in other ways) if they have five or more drinks of an alcoholic beverage once or twice a week? (higher is better)  
Q9. CLYDE Survey 2021 69.4%  
Q12. CLYDE Survey 2023 70.1% (\*0.7%)  
**Focus Group Data needed: perception of risk of alcohol use vs other substances**  
**Projected date: Fall 2024 Target Population: HS youth at ICSD**  
**ADULT SURVEYS – perception of risk**  
**Projected date: Fall 2024 Target Population: Adults in the community at various events**

**Root Cause 1.2:  
Access to alcohol**

**Measure, Data, Source & Date #1:**  
Youth feel alcohol is very easy to obtain.  
Q.19 CLYDE Survey 2021 18.1%  
p.31 CLYDE Survey 2023 16% (√2.1%)  
**Measure, Data, Source & Date #2:**  
**Focus Group Data needed:**  
**Q. Where are youth getting alcohol?**  
**Projected date: Fall 2024 Target Population: HS youth at ICSD**

**Local Condition 1.1a:**  
Youth in 12<sup>th</sup> grade are drinking at home (theirs or someone else's) other than post-prom parties.

**Measure, Data, Source & Date #1:**  
If you drank alcohol, where did you drink it?  
Q85. At home CLYDE Survey 2021 12<sup>th</sup> Grade 73.1%  
Q88. At home CLYDE Survey 2023 12<sup>th</sup> Grade 60.5%  
**Measure, Data, Source & Date #2:**  
Q85. At someone else's home CLYDE Survey 2021 12<sup>th</sup> Grade 79.4%  
Q88. At someone else's home CLYDE Survey 2023 12<sup>th</sup> Grade 78.9%  
**Informal Key Informant Interview (July 2023) with HS seniors - respondents indicated they did not think youth alcohol use was a major problem as it is a "social thing" not an everyday thing for most who use. Focus Group Data needed: on what other occasions are youth drinking at home/s other than post-prom. Projected date: Fall 2024 Target Population: 12<sup>th</sup> grade students at ICSD**

**Local Condition 1.1b:**  
Youth are drinking alcohol provided by parents (and with parents/other adults) at 12<sup>th</sup> grade post-prom parties.

**Measure, Data, Source & Date #1:**  
Informal Key Informant Interview June 2024 – reported an after-prom party where alcohol was available, supplied by parents. Parents/adults were also drinking with the youth.  
**Measure, Data, Source & Date #2:**  
**Focus Group Data needed: Parent focus groups – when, where, who, perception of risk. Projected date: Winter 2024-5, Target Population: Parents of HS students at ICSD**

**Local Condition 1.2a:**  
Youth obtain alcohol from home with parental permission.

**Measure, Data, Source & Date #1:**  
If you drank alcohol, how did you usually get it  
Q84. I got it from home with my parents permission CLYDE Survey 2021 51.7%  
**Measure, Data, Source & Date #2:**  
Q87. I got it from home with my parents permission CLYDE Survey 2023 50.0%

**Local Condition 1.2b:**  
Youth obtain alcohol at parties that do not happen at people's homes.

**Measure, Data, Source & Date #1:**  
Q85 Youth get alcohol from parties CLYDE 2021 38.2%  
Q88 Youth get alcohol from parties CLYDE 2023 46.1% \*7.9  
**Measure, Data, Source & Date #2:**  
Informal Key Informant Interview 2024: Sheriff's Office reported breaking up a large party of underage youth that occurred in the woods along power line access area, not during prom or graduation times.  
**Focus group data needed: Q. Who is going to the parties, who is hosting, where, who provides the alcohol?**  
**Projected date: Fall 2024 Target Population: HS youth at ICSD**
