**Root Cause 1.1:
Social Access**

CLYDE 2023. QE3. Has anyone asked you to vape cannabis in the past year? Grade 12: 28.4% (All Grades: 13.6%)
Measure, Data, Source & Date #2:
Clyde 2023. If you wanted to get some marijuana, how easy would it be for you to get some? VERY EASY Grade 12: 23.9% All Grades: 9.4% (P32. Crosstabs)

Measure, Data, Source & Date #1:
CLYDE 2023. Past 30-day use
Grade 12: 12.4%

CLYDE 2023. Lifetime use
Grade 12: 26.8% (Table 14)

**Root Cause 1.2:
Perception of Harm**

Measure, Data, Source & Date #1:
CLYDE Data 2023. How much do you think people risk harming themselves (physically or in other ways) if they smoke marijuana regularly (once or twice a week)? 12th Grade 30.5%, DFC Core Measure 2, Table 8.
Measure, Data, Source & Date #2:
CLYDE Data 2023, How wrong do your parents feel it would be for you to smoke marijuana? 12th Grade 23.2%, Q13

Local Condition 1.1a:
Youth obtain cannabis at parties.

Measure, Data, Source & Date #1:
Clyde 2023. I got it at a party. Grade 12: 31.8% All Grades: 28.6% (Table 19).

FOCUS Group Data needed. Where are the parties, who attends, more info.

Local Condition 1.1b:
Youth obtain cannabis from other youth/students.

Measure, Data, Source & Date #1:
Clyde 2023. I got it from someone I know under age 21. Grade 12: 68.2% All Grades: 60.7% (Table 19)
Measure, Data, Source & Date #2:
Focus Group data needed. Where is the source getting it from? How?

Local Condition 1.2a:
Lack of perceived consequences (health, social, legal, school etc).
